

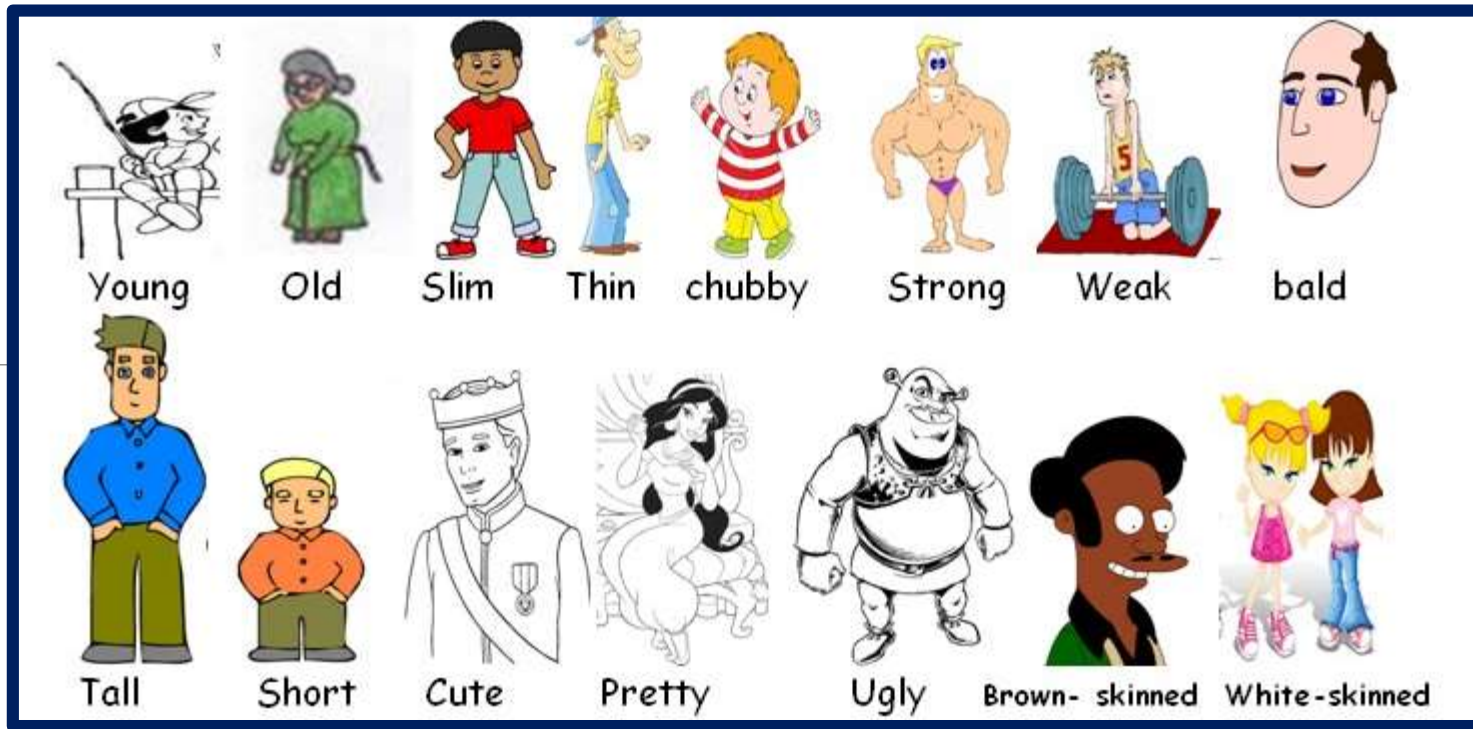

Well, maybe all Australians are good looking!

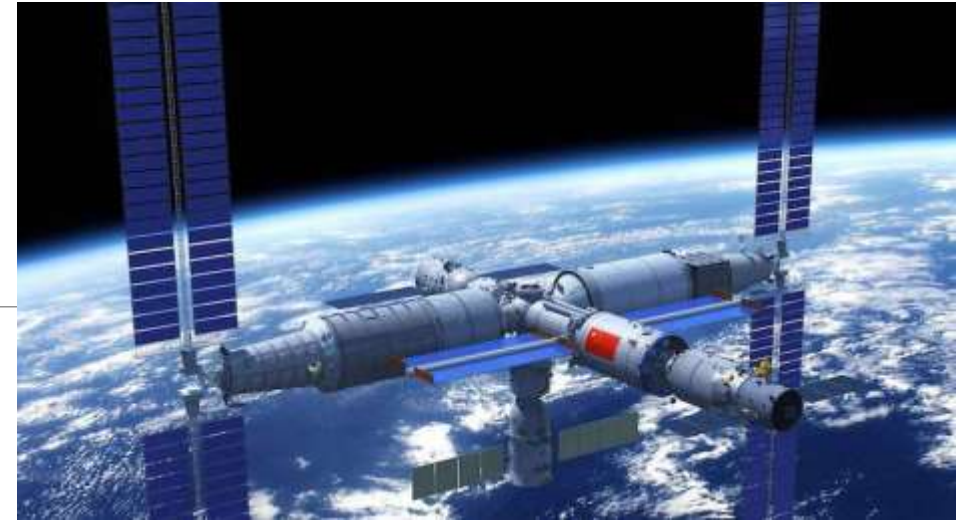

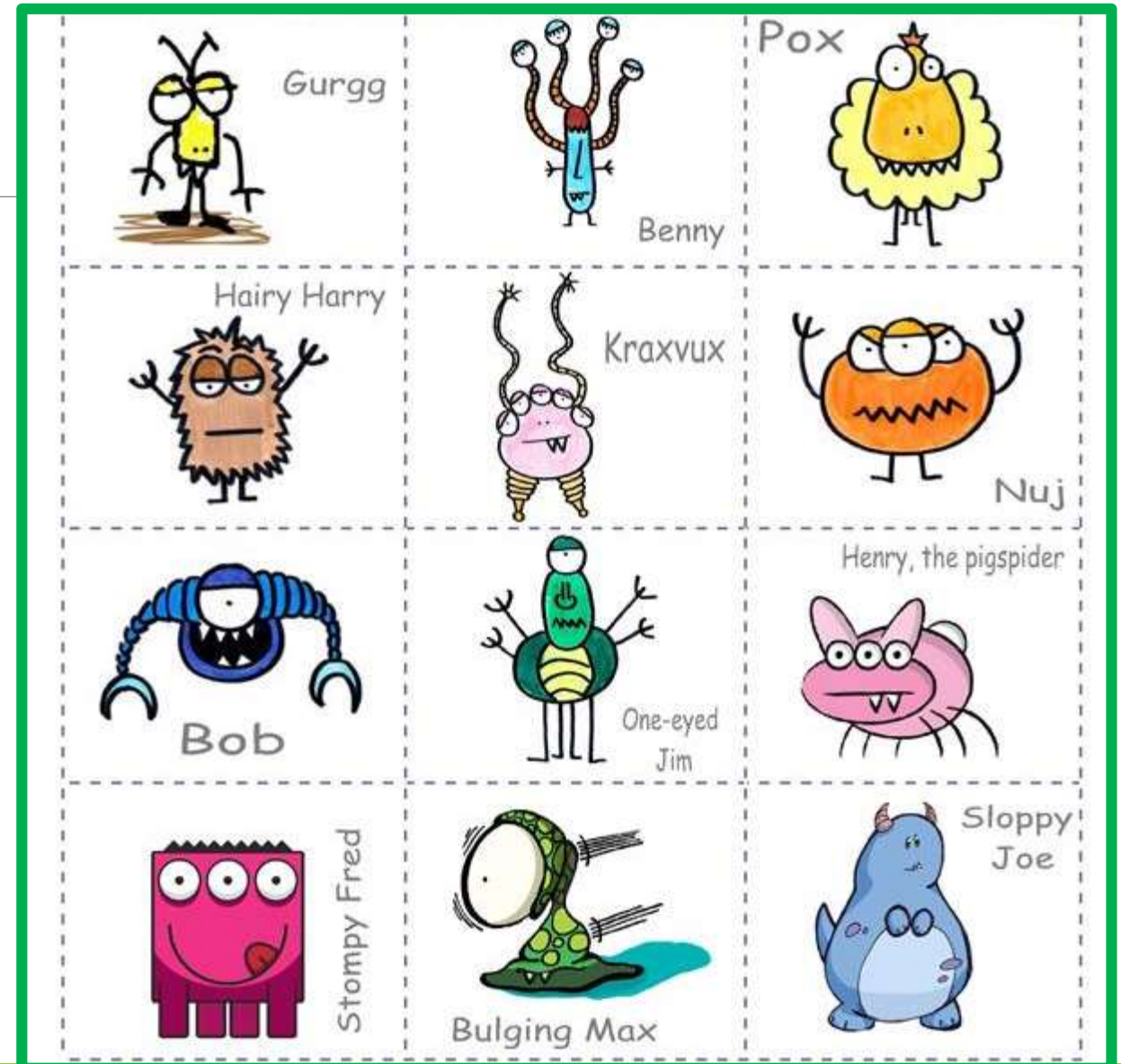
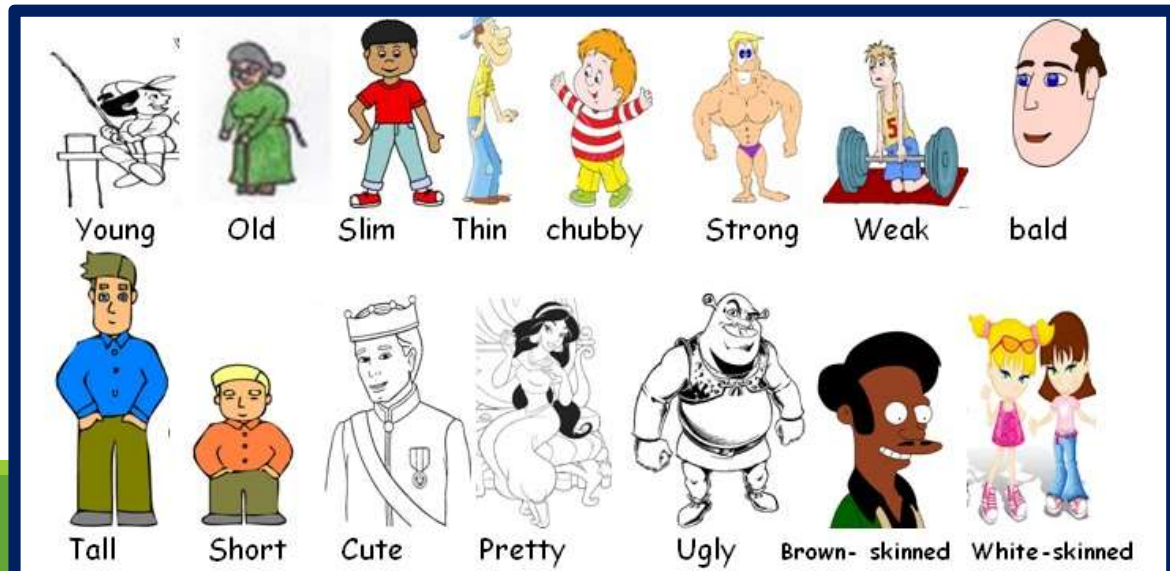
